

1 How does this option work?

This alternative allows eligible candidates to complete a professional learning module instead of retaking the entire Praxis test.

2 Who is eligible?

- Candidates that have attempted any of the tests currently offered for Praxis Bridge.
- Candidates who have scored within 1 SEM of the state passing score as defined by their state licensure agency.
- Candidates who want to teach in a state that has adopted the program.

3 How do I know if my state participates in Praxis Bridge and what test titles they allow?

Visit your state overview page on the Praxis website. If your state has adopted Bridge, information on which titles are available will be provided there.

4 How much does this cost?

The Praxis Bridge is \$50.

5 Why is 1 SEM the qualifying factor?

The 1 SEM threshold represents candidates that are close to passing a state's adopted cut score and will have a good chance of successfully completing the test when retaking without any additional preparation. Candidates that are below this threshold likely need more test preparation or learning to ensure they understand the content.

6 When and how will I be notified if I'm eligible?

If you are eligible, you will be notified via email when you receive your official Praxis scores. The option will also appear in your Praxis account when your official scores are available.

NOTE: You do not automatically qualify for Bridge for each test you did not pass. You must score within 1 SEM of your state's passing score to be eligible. If you qualify, you will automatically receive an email for the test titles you are eligible for, and they will appear in your Praxis account.

7 How does ETS identify the module I need to take?

ETS Praxis will identify the content category on which you scored the lowest and then make that specific module available to you.

For Bridge for Core Academic Skills for Educators, there is only one module per subtest (Reading, Writing, Mathematics). If you qualify for Bridge for any of the subtests, ETS Praxis will make that module available to you.

8 How do I access the course once I've registered for it?

You will receive an email with a link to the module. You can also access that link from your Praxis account. You will have access to both the link and the module for 6 months from the date of purchase.

9 If I received an eligibility email but I have already retaken and passed the test, do I need to complete Bridge?

No – if you have already retested and met the passing score requirements you do not need to complete the Bridge module(s).

10 How long is the module?

The module will take approximately 45 minutes to complete, but it is untimed and asynchronous.

11 What does Praxis Bridge module look like?

The module provides content overviews, practice items with annotations, and a knowledge check. All stages help test takers define key concepts and affirm their understanding of the material.

12 What are the technical requirements for Praxis Bridge module?

You are not required to download any additional software or plug-ins or install any additional hardware for this training program. The platform is supported by all major browsers and operating systems including PCs, Mac®, iPad®, and Android. It is also compatible with all major screen-reading software for visually impaired users.



13 What if I don't score 100% on my knowledge check?

You are required to achieve a score of 75%-80% on the knowledge check. If you score lower than that percentage range, you will be routed to the questions that you got incorrect, and the system will provide hints for those items. You will then have unlimited chances to answer the remaining items correctly before you can proceed.

14 How long do I have to complete the module?

You will have 6 months from the date of purchase to complete Praxis Bridge. If you do not complete the module within 6 months you will need to re-register for a full Praxis retake.

15 My state allows multiple measures for licensure. Should I wait to register for the test if my unofficial score is not pass?

Yes, we recommend that you wait for your official Praxis scores to see if you are eligible for Praxis Bridge - especially if you are close to the passing score. To find out when your official scores will be available, please visit:

16 If I already re-registered for a new test, can I receive a refund?

Yes, you will need to contact customer service to request a refund. We recommend you wait until you receive your official Praxis scores to see if you are eligible for Praxis Bridge.

17 Are the answers saved after each question? Is it possible to return where you left off?

Yes, the answers are saved, and you can return where you left off.

18 How does my score change?

You will receive a Certificate of Completion upon successfully finishing the module. You will also be issued an updated Praxis Score Report that will indicate "Alt. Passed" for the specific subject-area test. The new score report will be issued within 5 business days after the module has been successfully completed.

19 How do I provide feedback on the modules?

At the end of the learning module, there will be a short survey where you can provide feedback.
